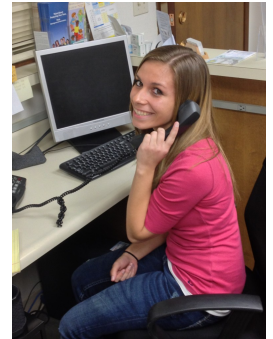




What is Grays Harbor Youth Works?

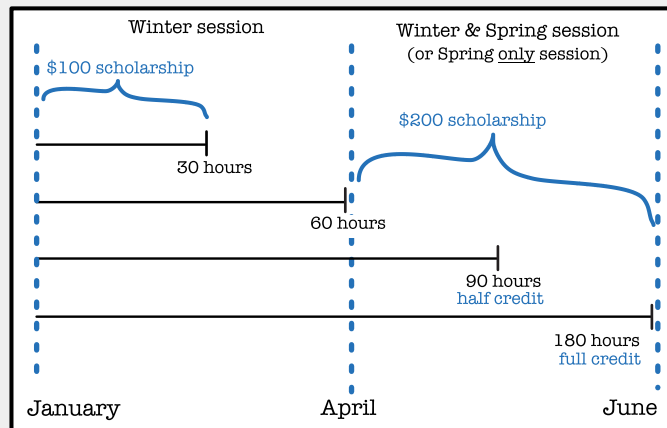
Grays Harbor Youth Works is a nonprofit organization dedicated to providing internship opportunities for high school students in Grays Harbor County. While we are the framework for this experience and have routine communication with students, they will be matched with an employer host/mentor who will be their main supervisor.



What is my role as a parent/guardian?

The parent/guardian is responsible for supporting and encouraging their child throughout the internship, providing transportation when needed, and being present at the Orientation and Recognition Event. For specific dates, visit our website at www.graysharboryouthworks.com

What is the timeline?



Students choose to complete either a 30, 60, 90, or 180 hour internship.

This determines the benefits they are eligible to earn such as scholarship money and school credit.

How does transportation work?

Students are responsible for their own transportation. They can earn scholarship money which can be used towards transportation needs i.e. bus pass, gas, etc.

Who will my student be working with?

A GHYW mentor is a responsible adult who is selected by the employer and serves as a trusted ally and guide for the student intern. They help to ensure that the student develops important trade and life skills while learning about available opportunities and resources. These are individuals who have fulfilled our application requirements as well as a WA State Background Check. They will become great connections for your student and may assist them in attaining future employment.

We conduct a workplace safety assessment prior to every internship. Additionally, we provide employers with liability and L&I coverage.
