SUPPORT SERVICES

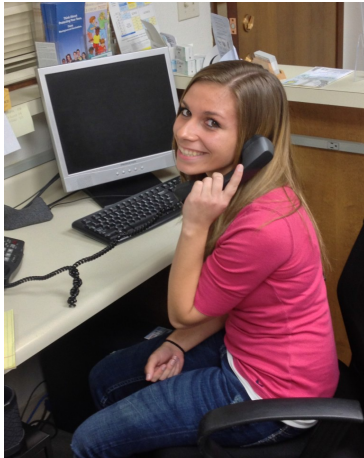
